



Civil Engineers' Club Walk



This event is being organised by the Civil Engineers' Club, but any friends wishing to join us will be welcome.

Please note that pre-registration on a first come first served basis (see details on next page) is required in order to comply with Covid regulations, and the number of attendees will be restricted.

Date: Saturday 25 September 2021

Time: We meet at 10.00 am and start walking at 10.15 am

Meeting Point: On the south bank of the River Thames under Hungerford Bridge by the Royal Festival Hall. The nearest railway station is Waterloo Main Line
Waterloo Station is on the Jubilee, Bakerloo and Northern tube Lines

Distance The distance will be about 8 miles, 5.5 miles before lunch and 2.5 miles afterwards.

Terrain The walk is flat

Background This walk is one of a series taken over several years by ICE along the Thames Towpath from Hampton Court to the Thames Barrier via Richmond, Putney, Waterloo and Greenwich.

Overview: The walk will follow the Thames Towpath from Waterloo to Greenwich

Route: We follow the Thames Path downstream past various historic locations including the Globe Theatre and City Hall until we reach Tower Bridge.
At this point the character of the environment changes and it becomes less affluent. We pass through Bermondsey and Rotherhithe, with the Brunel Museum continuing past the site of the slipway for the Great Eastern on the opposite bank until we arrive in Deptford for lunch.
After lunch, we continue to Greenwich where the walk will end. Walkers will have the opportunity to visit some of the exhibits at this historic location.

Lunch: Lunch will be at the Ship and Whale pub at about 1.00 pm
A menu will be circulated with this flyer to facilitate pre-ordering.

Please book by **email to me** with the information listed below.

I will acknowledge your place on the walk and your place is **not** confirmed until that is done.

Since places are limited, please be sure to inform me immediately if you are unable to take up a reserved place.

We are having to complete a risk assessment for the walk, and some of the risks of course relate to Covid-19. To save having to repeat messages at the beginning of the walk, please note the following points:

- You may only join the walk if you have pre-booked with the leader. You will be turned away if you have not booked;
- If possible, please do not share transport to the start of the walk;
- Please maintain social distancing while on the walk. At any stiles or kissing gates, please touch them as little as possible and keep your distance from the person ahead of you;
- Please carry and use your own hand sanitiser. You may want to carry a face mask in case of any incident, but you do not need to wear it while walking;
- Do not share drink, food or equipment.

We have all become used to these restrictions in our own lives over the past months, so hopefully it will not be an onerous task for us to comply with them on our group walks.
