Saint Barbara Day Walk

Date: Saturday 4 December 2021

Time: We met at 1200 hrs and started walking at 1215 hrs

Meeting Point: In the piazza outside the Royal Exchange, by Bank Station

Distance The distance was about 5.5 km.

Terrain The walk was flat.

Background This Joint CEC and BTSYM walk commemorated National Tunnelling Day 2021 and St Barbara Day, whilst passing by shafts and headhouses of various new and historic tunnels. The majority of the walking route also ran parallel with the alignment of Thames Tideway Tunnel.

Overview: The walk followed King William St from Bank to Monument, then Thames Path from Monument to Limehouse Basin (end).

Route: We congregated at Bank Station and then headed towards Monument. From there, we continued walking eastwards, downstream, along the Thames Path; finishing at Limehouse Basin.
The said route included headhouses and shafts associated with historic and new tunnels. Additionally, we were also able to observe the Bank Station Capacity Upgrade and Thames Tideway Tunnel construction sites from public access.
