



Civil Engineers' Club Walk

This event is being organised by the Civil Engineers' Club, but any friends wishing to join us will be welcome.



Date: Saturday 24 September 2022

Time: Meet at 10.00 am for Start at 10.15 am

Meeting Point: Outside Twickenham station main entrance

Distance The distance will be about 3 miles before lunch and 2 miles after lunch

Overview: This walk includes part of the Capital Ring and the Thames Pathway ending at the London Museum of Water and Steam for a one hour guided tour at a subsidised nominal rate of £2. Note the entry ticket is valid for a year.

Route: Starting at Twickenham Station, walk through Twickenham, head towards the Thames, head past Glovers Island, view of Petersham Meadows, past flats and houses to Richmond Bridge. We then join the Capital Ring, re-joining the river further up at Twickenham Bridge. the tree-lined embankment of Ranelagh Drive arrives at Richmond Lock footbridge, where lock and sluices help control the level of the Thames. Continue North to our lunch stop.

After lunch continue along the Thames path for short stretch before entering Syon Park, crossing through the park to Brentford High Street. Turning right and crossing the Brentford bridge over the Grand Union Canal, through the small housing estate, heading back towards the main road, before following this, a short stretch to the London Museum of Water and Steam Museum.
