Date: Saturday 11th November 2023

Time: Meet at 10:00 am

Meeting Point: Paddington Underground Station entrance on Praed Street (opposite

Hilton London Paddington)

Distance: The distance will be about 3 miles before lunch and about 3 miles in the

afternoon.

Terrain: We'll be walking along mostly flat pavements with some possible steps.

Walking shoes are optional. Warm clothing and waterproofs may be

advisable.

Overview: In commemoration of 160 years since the opening of the oldest metro

system in the world you will be learning a bit about its history and developments. The walk will include the oldest section of the London Underground from Paddington Station to Farringdon Station at surface level. The walk will also continue along the tube route up to Tower Hill. We'll be stopping at various locations for refreshments and to appreciate

different aspects of the underground transport system.

Route: The start will be from Paddington Underground Station to King's Cross

Underground Station in the morning. There will be a break for lunch around King's Cross. In the afternoon we'll continue to walk from King's Cross to Farringdon and then onto Tower Hill. There will be a number of stops along the route to admire some particular features of the tube.

Lunch: Lunch will be at Kings Cross.

There are numerous restaurants, cafes, pubs and fast-food outlets.
