

## **Walks for Civil Engineers**

Title: Walk on Wimbledon and Putney Commons

**Date:** Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> November 2024

Meeting Point: Wimbledon Park Underground Railway Station on the District Line.

Walk starts at 10am

**Distance:** Distance will be about 9 miles

Finish Point: Wimbledon Main Line Railway Station

**Terrain:** Footpaths are good, but could be muddy in places depending on the weather.

Good walking shoes/boots are recommended. It is a predominately flat walk with

slight inclines at either end.

**Overview:** This is a repeat of a linear walk arranged by Richard Lucas in 2010 and covers

Wimbledon Park and Wimbledon and Putney Commons the latter being a SSSI

and a Special Area of Conservation. The Commons are 460 acres and

encompass the largest expanse of heathland in the London area and is a fine place for walking, joggers and ramblers. It is also the base for the Thames Hare and Hounds; founded in 1868 and the oldest adult cross country running club in

the world. There are no steps or stiles.

**Route:** The walk will be on a mixture of town roads and rural paths and will go through

Wimbledon Park and then pass by the All England Lawn Tennis Club onto the Commons passing by the Windmill where there might be time for a quick coffee. Then following close to the NW and West sides of the Commons along the Beverly Brook and then East past Caesar's Camp for lunch at the Fox and Grapes. After lunch there is the opportunity to walk around the grounds of Cannizaro House before heading past Rushmere Pond and Wimbledon Village

where we will pass by Oliver Read's favourite Dog & Fox Pub and lots of smart

shops before heading downhill to Wimbledon Station.
