Title: Kemsing/Heaverham Circular Walk

Date: Saturday 5th April 2025

Time: Meet at 10.15 am

Anyone wishing to come by train *please email Stewart Biggs* and we will

arrange a lift from the station back to Kemsing Village.

Train times: 1 per hour.

Coming from Ashford (via Maidstone East) – arrives 9.59 (returning 46 mins

passed the hour)

Coming from London Bridge (via Otford) – arrives 9.46 (returning 59 mins

passed the hour)

Meeting at: Kemsing Village Car Park High Street TN15 6NA Free car parking.

Distance: The distance will be about 5 miles before lunch and 1 ½ miles after lunch.

Terrain: One steep climb (at the start) and one moderate descent. Will be muddy in

places if wet. Walking boots essential (trainers definitely not advisable).

Overview: A circular North Downs escarpment walk that takes in views across the Vale

of Holmesdate to the Greensand Ridge.

Route: Starting from Kemsing Village, the walk heads north out of the village to the

Pilgrims Way. We cross the Pilgrims Way and head up a steep path to the North Downs Way. Heading east along the North Downs Way it is possible to see stunning views across the Vale of Holmesdate. We will descend from

the North Downs Way through the 17th Century St Clere estate to

Heaverham returning to Kemsing village after lunch.

Lunch: Lunch will be at 1pm at The Chequers in Heaverham. We have provisionally
