Friday 13th June: Meet at 2.00pm at The Cotswold Canal Trust Visitor Centre, Bell House, Wallbridge, Stroud, GL5 3JS, for a welcome and an introductory talk about the Cotswold Canal Trust and the restoration of the canal. Followed by a guided walk and boat trip between Wallbridge, Stroud and Bowbridge (approx. 50 minutes).

Please note, there is no parking on site at Wallbridge but there is a pay and display a few minutes' walk away.

Friday evening: Meal at a Restaurant in Stroud.

Saturday 14th June: Meet at 9.45am for a guided walk from Stonehouse Court Hotel to Fromebridge Mill – Approx 3.5 miles.

After lunch there will be an option to continue the guided walk from Fromebridge Mill to Saul Junction – Approx 2 miles

Sunday 15th June: Meet at Saul Junction Visitor Centre, where there will be a chance to explore the area around Saul Junction Pay and display parking on site.
