- Title:** Walking the Boat Race route from Putney to Barnes
- Date:** Saturday 13th April 2024
- Time:** We meet at 10.00 am and start walking at 10.15 am
- Meeting Point:** Meet outside the River Café which is opposite the exit of Putney Bridge Tube station (District line).
(What3Words gallons.burn.votes)
- Distance:** Distance will be about 8 miles
- Terrain:** Mostly paved. Good walking shoes are recommended. Warm clothing and waterproofs may be advisable depending on the weather.
- Overview:** A walk along the north bank of the River Thames from Putney Bridge to Barnes via Hammersmith and Chiswick. After lunch we walk back to Putney Bridge via Barnes Common and Putney Lower Common.
- Route:** There will be a chance to visit the grave of William Hogarth and walk through the grounds of Chiswick House.

About a 2.5 hour walk before lunch and then another one hour after lunch to return to Putney Bridge Tube station.
- Lunch:** Lunch will be at the Bulls Head in Barnes. A menu has been provided and lunch orders should be advised when registering for the walk.
- Toilets:** Toilets along the route are limited. However, there are a number of pubs and cafes around Hammersmith which may allow use of their facilities
